It is to submit that the School Health Program has been launched on 14.11.2010 covering nearly 80000 schools and 80.00 lakhs children's with the following expected level of achievements.

- No. of Schools covered: 80,000
- Class covered: Class 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>
- Number of students to be screened: 80 lakhs
- School Health Day: Every Thursday
- WIFS: weekly once every Thursday
- School referral day: Every Tuesday
- De worming : Every 6 Months/Two times a year
- School adopted by health teams: 80,000
- Every Health team has one Health provider from DM&HO, Education provider from DoSe.(School Health Coordinator).
- For every student a unique ID is generated
- Every student is issue a school Health and Education record.
- Effective and Efficient intersect oral convergence
- Department converged: Health, Education & All welfare Departments of GoAP.

In this regard the SWASTHH ON WHEELS has to be taken up for educating and creating awareness on Jawahar Bala Arogya Raksha (JBAR) and Adolescent Reproductive and Sexual Health (ARSH) activities.

The Objective of the SWASTHH ON WHEEL is to create awareness on JBAR and ARSH Activities, in addition to creating awareness, on the following.

12. Parental Trainings
13. Aids and Appliances
14. Strengthening of Arogya Clubs
15. Change agents **CHINNARI DOCTORS**
16. Social access by School Management Committee/Parent Teacher Association.

The above decorated vehicle will be utilized From 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2012 to 26<sup>th</sup> Jan 2013.. It will cover all the PHCs & Mandal's modern SWASTHH School in the concerned Districts.

The District level tour program and topics to be discussed will be prepared and activities will be generated by the state level / District level Committees.

**Swasth on wheels: Innovative**

**A) THENHE**

This program is to create awareness among the community through child to child, child to parents and family & Community by educating the children during morning prayer assembly

- On Monday : Teeth & Tongue
- Tuesday : Hair & Head
- Wednesday : Ear & Eyes
- Thursday : Nose & Nails
- Friday : Heart & Hands
- Saturday : Equipment & Empowerment

(Such as availability of required Books, Uniform/Cloths, Disability problems and Life Skills).

“THEN” means at a later date by implementing the above practices to the school children.

“HE” That is the student will develop as a healthy and prosperous citizen.

**B) SWASTHH on wheels – Arogya Mela.**

This program is designed to create awareness to the entire community on SCHOOL, WATER, and SANITASTION towards HEALTH & HYGIENE. Which are important components to maintain health of an individual .

A vehicle is proposed for each district which is decorated with all IEC material including public addressing system and Video.

This vehicle will move Mandal to Mandal on a prefixed date. In a campaigned mode. This vehicle will be parked at SWASTHH School which is already identified. The Vehicle will be received by the community of the local leaders, teachers, Students ,Parents , Health staff including Medical Officer, Mandal level officials , NGOs & CBOs. Mandal level school health coordinators as per GO 319 (MEO & MO) are responsible for conducting this event in festive spirit.

In this program they will organize science exhibition from school, Health staff will exhibit health related programs , ICDS department will exhibit the nutrition food, and also conduct Medical Camp followed by cultural programs on various healthy practices by telling the success stories and taking feed back by the parents to the community on the referral treatment.

After conducting the AROGYA Mela in a festival atmosphere the vehicle will move on to the next Mandal as per the schedule and same activity will be replicated there

**C) CHIP Capacity building.**

Under **Child holistic improvement program** the selected students from Arogya clubs will be trained in best health practices, leadership qualities & life skills. After attaining the above competencies they will named as **CHINNARI DOCTORS** and their services will be utilized to develop the skills of other children on par with them including supporting JBAR program.

**D) NGO roles & responsibilities participation.**

- 1) The NGOs with corporate back ground will provide financial assistance and professional services.
- 2) The NGOs with relative experience in the field will provide services.

3) Some NGOs will canvass for adopting schools be employees with social responsibility. In turn the people with social responsibility will visit the schools in selected dates and help

CHNC wise agency biggest high school to be identified in all the mandals as SWASTHH School i.e. from KGBV / Ashram school / Residential school / Hostel attached school.

One day program at one area there should be a parents gathering school health coordinator (HM), Para Medical staff, medical health camp, Arogya club, Exhibition, which should be included along with local leaders, Mahila Mandal samakya and community for awareness and tom-tom/publicity to be taken up 2 – 3 days before the program.

The CHNC, SPHO / Local MEO has to prepare route map along with detailed guidelines and approval of District Collector, DM&HO, PO (RVM), DEO & PDICDS. The PO (RVM) and DEO, SE/RWS should arrange facilities and requirements in the consult Mandals.

At the end of the program appreciation to be given to best PHC, school, club, teacher, coordinator (Para-medical), educator etc. to be given by District collector / Administrator.
